Luke 16:1-13

- 1 Now He was also saying to the disciples, "There was a rich man who had a <u>manager</u>, and *this charge was brought* to him *namely that the manager was squandering his possessions.*
- 2 And he called him and said to him, 'What is this I hear about you? Give an accounting of your <u>management</u>, for you can no longer be manager.'
- The <u>manager</u> said to himself, 'What shall I do, since my master is taking the <u>management</u> away from me? I am not strong enough to dig; I am ashamed to beg.
- 4 'I know what I shall do, so that when I am removed from the management, people will welcome me into their homes.'
- And he summoned each one of his master's debtors, and he *began* saying to the first, 'How much do you owe my master?'
- And he said, 'A hundred measures of oil.' And he said to him, 'Take your bill, and sit down quickly and write fifty.'
- 7 Then he said to another, 'And how much do you owe?' And he said, 'A hundred measures of wheat.' He said to him, 'Take your bill, and write eighty.'
- And his master praised the *unrighteous* manager because he had acted *shrewdly* (*he thought and prepared for the future*); for the sons of this age are *more shrewd* in relation to their own kind than the sons of light.
- 9 And I *emphatically* say to you, make friends for yourselves by means of the *mammon* of *unrighteousness*, so that when it fails, they will receive you into the eternal dwellings.
- He who is faithful in a very little thing is faithful also in much; and he who is *unrighteous* in a very little thing is *unrighteous* also in much.
- Therefore if you have not been faithful in the *use of* unrighteous *mammon*, who will entrust the true *riches* to you?
- And if you have not been faithful in *the use of* that which is another's, who will give you that which is your own?
- 13 No servant can serve two masters; for either he will hate the one and love the other, or else he will be devoted to one and despise the other. You cannot serve God and *mammon*."
