Let's Look at the Book of Acts ~ June 16, 2013 "A Controversial Message" Acts 9:26-31 / Galatians 1:11-19 Galatians 1:11-19

- 11 For I would have you know, brethren, that the gospel which was preached by me is not according to man (based upon the measure or standard of man).
- 12 For I, emphatically, neither received it from man, nor was I, emphatically, taught it, but I, emphatically, received and was taught it by Jesus Christ's revelation.
- 13 For you have heard of my former manner of life in Judaism, how I used to persecute the church of God beyond measure and made havoc of it;
- 14 and I was advancing in Judaism beyond many of my contemporaries among my countrymen, being more extremely zealous for my ancestral traditions.
- 15 But when God, who had set me apart even from my mother's womb and called me through His grace, was pleased
- 16 to reveal His Son in me so that I might preach Him among the Gentiles, I did not immediately consult with flesh and blood,
- 17 nor did I go up to Jerusalem to those who were apostles before me; but I went away to Arabia, and returned once more to Damascus.
- 18 Then three years later I went up to Jerusalem to become acquainted with Cephas, and stayed with him fifteen days.
- 19 But I did not see any other of the apostles except James, the Lord's brother.

Acts 9:26-31

- When he came to Jerusalem, he was trying to associate with the disciples; but they were all afraid of him, not believing that he was a disciple.
- 27 But Barnabas took hold of him and brought him to the apostles and described to them how he had seen the Lord on the road, and that He had talked to him, and how at Damascus he had spoken out boldly in the name of Jesus.
- 28 And he was with them, moving about freely in Jerusalem, speaking out boldly in the name of the Lord.

- 29 And he was talking and arguing with the Hellenistic *Jews*; but they were attempting to put him to death.
- 30 But when the brethren learned *of it*, they brought him down to Caesarea and sent him away to Tarsus.

31	So the church throughout all Judea and Galilee and Samaria enjoyed peace, being built up; and going on in the fear of the Lord and in the comfort of the Holy Spirit, it continued to increase.
