### "A Conversion" Acts 9:1-9 with Acts 26:14-18

#### Acts 9:1-9

- 1 Now Saul, still breathing threats and murder against *the Lord's disciples*, went to the high priest,
- 2 and asked for letters from him to the synagogues at Damascus, so that if he found any *being of the Way*, both men and women, he might bring them bound to Jerusalem.
- 3 As he was traveling, it happened that he was approaching Damascus, and suddenly a light from heaven flashed around him;
- 4 and he fell to the ground and heard a voice saying to him, *in the Hebrew dialect* "Saul, Saul, why are you persecuting Me? *It is hard for you to be kicking against the goads."* (Acts 26:14)
- 5 And he said, "Who are You, Lord?" And He said, "I am Jesus whom you are persecuting,
- 6 but get up and enter the city, and it will be told you what you must do."

  Acts 26:16–18
- 16 ('But get up and stand on your feet; for this purpose I have appeared to you, to appoint you a *personal attendant* and a witness not only to the things which you have seen, but also to the things in which I will *become visible* to you;
- 17 **by freeing** you from **imprisonment to** the **Jewish** people and from the Gentiles, to whom I **myself**, am sending you,
- 18 to open their eyes

### with the result of their conversion

from darkness to light

and from the dominion of Satan to God,

- with the result of the forgiveness of sins and an inheritance among those who have been sanctified by faith namely, the one which is in Me.')
- 7 The men who traveled with him stood speechless, hearing the voice but seeing no one.
- 8 Saul got up from the ground, and though his eyes were open, he could see nothing; and leading him by the hand, they brought him into Damascus.
- 9 And he was three days without sight, and neither ate nor drank.
