John 3:16-21

Our Good God:

16 “For God so (***in this way***) loved the world,
that He gave ***the Son, the*** only begotten (***unique One***),

Those Who Believe:

that ***everyone who*** believes in Him should not ***continue in a lost state***, but have (***consistently possess***) eternal (***ageless***) life.

17 For God did not send the Son into the world ***in order that He would be judging*** the world, but that the world ***might obtain salvation*** through Him.

18 He who ***believes*** in Him is not ***being*** judged;

Those Who Will Not Believe:

he who does not ***believe in Him*** has been judged already, because he has not believed ***and does not believe*** in the name of the only begotten (***unique***) Son of God.

19 And this is the judgment, ***namely*** that the light ***has*** come into the world and men loved the darkness rather than the light; for their deeds were evil (***morally corrupt***).

20 For everyone who ***practices the inconsequential*** hates (***rejects***) the light, and does not come to the light, ***in order that his works*** should ***not*** be exposed ***for correction***.

21 But he who ***is doing*** the truth comes to the light, ***in order that his works would be disclosed that they had*** been ***accomplished*** in God.”
