Studies in John's Gospel

Part 36

"What the World Can't Conceive & Therefore Do"

John 12:30-50

Sunday February 21, 2021

- **30** Jesus answered and said, "This voice has not come for My sake, but for your sakes.
- **31** Now judgment is upon this world; now the ruler of this world shall be cast out.
- **32** And I, if I be lifted up from the earth, will draw (*through inner conviction*) all men to Myself."
- **33** But He was saying this *clarifying* the kind of death by which He was to die.
- **34** The multitude therefore answered Him, "We have heard out of the Law that the Christ is to remain forever; and how can You say, 'The Son of Man must be lifted up'? Who is this Son of Man?"
- **35** Jesus therefore said to them, "For a little while longer the light is among you. *Be walking* while you have the light, that darkness may not *gain control over* you; he who *is walking* in <u>the darkness</u> does not know where he *is going*.
- **36** While you have the light, *be believing* in the light, in order that you *would become* sons of light." These things Jesus spoke, and He departed and hid Himself from them.
- **37** But though He had performed so many signs before them, yet they were not believing in Him;
- **38** that the word of Isaiah the prophet might be fulfilled, which he spoke, "LORD, WHO HAS BELIEVED OUR REPORT? AND TO WHOM HAS THE ARM OF THE LORD BEEN REVEALED?"
- 39 Because of this they were unable to believe, for Isaiah said again,
- 40 "He has blinded their eyes, and He hardened their heart; in order that they should not see with their eyes, and perceive with their heart, and be converted, and I will heal them."
- **41** These things Isaiah said, because <u>he saw His glory, and he spoke *concerning* Him</u>.

- **42** Nevertheless many even of the rulers believed in Him, but because of the Pharisees they were not confessing Him, lest they should be put out of the synagogue;
- **43** for they loved the approval (*glory*) of men rather than the approval (*glory*) of God.
- **44** And Jesus cried out and said, "*The one who is believing* in Me *is not believing* in Me, but in Him who sent Me.
- **45** And he *who is observing* Me *is observing* the One who sent Me.
- **46** I, (*who am*) *light*, have come into the world, that everyone who *is believing* in Me *would* not remain in *the* darkness.
- **47** And if anyone hears My sayings, and does not *consider them important*, I *am not judging* him; for I did not come *in order that I should be judging* the world, but *in order that I should* save the world.
- **48** He who *is rejecting* Me, and *is not receiving* My sayings, has *the one who is judging* him; the word I spoke is what will judge him at the last day.
- **49** For I did not speak *of myself*, but the Father Himself who sent Me has given Me commandment, what *I should* say, and what *I should* speak.
- **50** And I know that His commandment is eternal life; therefore the things I speak, I speak just as the Father has told Me."
