14 The LORD God said to the serpent, "Because you have done

eat all the days of your life;	
15 And I will put <i>hostility</i> between you and the woman, and	
between your seed and her seed; he shall batter (crush) you on the	
nead, and you shall bruise him on the heel."	
16 To the woman He said, "I will greatly multiply your <u>pain</u> in	
childbirth, in <u>pain</u> you will bring forth children; yet your desire	
will be for your husband, and he will rule over you."	
17 Then to Adam He said, "Because you have listened to (obeyed)

he ground, because from it you were taken; for you are dust, and	
o dust you shall return."
